




As billed last month, here are club rock and rollers Jo and Adrian Dodd as seen at the Chippenham Lions event playing in their band called "The Cover Up".

When I think back to the flimsy envelops I used to send the film cartridges back to Agfa yet I only remember one occasion when a cartridge - 2 actually were returned broken and crumpled in the post. I was devastated.

The after dinner slide show soon became a much-loved or sometimes much-feared feature of visits to relatives or friends. The theatrical process of assembling the screen and loading the projector with slides in the hope that they were the correct way up when projected onto the screen. In those more simplistic days there was a sense of occasion lacking in our iPhone age.
